#### Who we are

Boys & Girls Club of Cornwall/SDG is a safe, fun and supervised place where children and youth from all cultural and economic backgrounds, can participate in social, recreational and educational programs that are designed to enhance growth, personal development and potential.

At Boys & Girls Club our vision is for all children and youth to discover and achieve their dreams and grow up to be healthy, successful and active participants in society. We are a registered charity and able to provide tax receipts for donations.

#### **Description of Project**

Our project is called the Leaders 4 Life program.

Leaders 4 Life is an innovative leadership program that focuses on engaging youth in our community to learn different skills essential to becoming a leader in their school, community, or workplace. The skills discussed throughout the program are; **communication skills** (i.e. social skills, professional skills, listening skills, and professional skills), **decision making skills**, **conflict resolution skills**, and general **leadership skills**. Leaders 4 Life also aids with resume building, and the opportunity to earn community service hours needed to obtain their high school diploma. Participants in this program are expected to attend one two-hour session weekly, for a period of 10-weeks. After they complete the 10-week program they will then be expected to complete a minimum of 5 hours of volunteer work in their community. Based on their participation in this program, a youth can earn up to 25 community service hours. *We would be looking to deliver program at local school or community group.* 

Leaders 4 Life is a program that will hopefully instill morals, values, and beliefs that will guide them into becoming a positive role model in their community.

To date Leaders 4 Life has been facilitated in our Boys & Girls Club Teen Program and various high schools in Cornwall. *To date, we've had 40 youth complete the program with over 80% attendance*.

In the future, with financial assistance we hope to deliver this program in different high school's in SDG.

## **Estimated cost of project**

\$10 000. A detailed budget will be provided upon request. Boys & Girls Club relies on grants and fundraisers to offsets costs of all our children and youth programs. Over 60% of our total revenue comes directly from Cornwall/SDG.
